

## **FLIGHT RATES FOR FY10**

The university flight rate is \$5.82 per nautical mile.

The university partners' flight rate is \$3.88 per nautical mile.

The flight rates are all inclusive except for circumstances such as extended layovers of more than a 24 hour period or other special requests.

Examples of special requests would be for flight service to arrange for catering costing \$75 or greater, ground transportation such as rental cars or limo service, etc. The actual cost of the special request will be added to the user's bill.

Extended layover will be referred to as RON (remain over night) and is defined as each additional 24 hour period beyond the first 24 hour period in which the aircraft is away from the home base of operation and is not flown.

The charge for an extended layover (RON) will be at the fixed rate of \$650 per extended period and has been estimated as follows:

### Aircraft expenses:

Total RON expenses: **\$650**

The university flight rate fee to relocate the aircraft when used in lieu of extended stays or in combinations with "drop-offs or pickups" of passengers or other scheduling conflicts will be assessed by the flight hour at the rate of \$650 per flight hour. This rate has been estimated as follows:

Cost of fuel per flight hour	\$450
