

Iowa Smokefree Air Act

The Iowa Smokefree Air Act was enacted during the recently completed legislative session and becomes effective on July 1, 2008. While smoking has been prohibited in buildings on the Iowa State University campus for some time, this act prohibits smoking at any location on the campus or any of its farm property. This includes all areas of the construction sites that your firm may be working on and any parking lots, athletic fields or other outdoor areas that your personnel may utilize. Smoking is also prohibited inside any vehicle and construction offices and trailers within construction sites.

This new law also applies to projects at the Iowa Braille and Sight Saving School in Vinton and the Iowa School for the Deaf in Council Bluffs.
