How to print Building Floor Plans PDF files without Problems

If you are getting black boxes or lines through the room numbers, please change the print to print the PDF as an image. To do this, in Internet Explorer, click on the down arrow next to the printer icon, and select print. (Do NOT just click the printer icon unless there is no down arrow next to it). A window like Figure 1 should appear.
